

The Salem Foundation – Elizabeth A. Hoke Scholarship Fund Scholarship Information

Applications will be accepted through April 1, 2022.

ELIGIBILITY

For the 2021 – 2022 school year, applications will be accepted from graduating seniors attending public or private high schools within the Silver Falls School District, the North Santiam 29J School District, and the Mt. Angel School District. Applicants must be planning to attend an accredited college or university in the Fall of 2022.

SELECTION

The criteria for selection will be:

1. Active participation in one of the eight participation areas below (choose one).
2. Grade point average of 2.75 or higher.

Financial need will be taken into consideration but is not a requirement to receive the award.

Relatives of the Scholarship Review Committee are not eligible to receive the scholarship.

AMOUNT AND PURPOSE

There are eight participation areas (see below). Students are to choose one – and only one – of the participation areas as the area in which they have been most involved or that means the most to them. One scholarship recipient will be chosen from each participation area. The amount of each scholarship is \$1,000.

Should no applications be received for one or more of the participation areas, the scholarship committee has the discretion to make more than one award from another participation area or to award fewer awards.

This scholarship may be used for tuition, room, board, books and fees, and will be paid directly to your college or university for your benefit.

PARTICIPATION AREAS

Choose the one area that means the most to you or in which you have been the most involved. Your participation in this area may have occurred at school or in the community, or both.

- **Music** - for a student who demonstrates a love for music regardless of chosen college major.
- **Dance** – for a student who understands what it means to dance in the rain and who has an enthusiasm for both life and dance.
- **Arts** – for a student demonstrating a love for and a pursuit of any area of the creative arts.
- **Foreign Language** – for a student who has the intention of putting foreign language skills into action.
- **Sports** – for a student who participated in sports during high school and demonstrated a desire to play hard and give great effort.
- **Future Farmers of America** – for a student who participated in FFA and who exhibits the qualities and characteristics that exemplify the FFA creed.
- **Valedictorian** – for a high school valedictorian who has a strong track record of helping others.
- **Science** – for a female student who plans to major in science.
